Safeguarding: Are they safe?

Safeguarding is everyone's responsibility. Do you know how to fulfil your safeguarding responsibilities to recognise abuse and report it correctly?

If you work, or volunteer, with children and/or adults at risk of harm we have training that can help you.

14 October: Introduction to Safeguarding

This course is an ideal introduction, Quality Assured by the Suffolk Safeguarding Partnership, to equip you with fundamental safeguarding knowledge and skills.

It covers both children and adults so you can support families better. It is also suitable as refresher training for those who need to renew their safeguarding training.

This new course is for Designated Safeguarding Leads. It will cover the role of a Safeguarding Lead in making referrals and their involvement afterwards.

It provides a deeper and more detailed understanding of:

- Professional disputes and escalation,
- Legislation and learning from Serious Case Reviews.
